



ATTN: Oticon hearing aid users: The Oticon **On** app is being **discontinued**.



1. Open your Oticon **On** app.



2. Follow prompt to download Oticon **Companion** app.



3. Open new app and ensure your hearing aids are paired.

Note: If your hearing aids do not appear in the app, re-pair them to your phone. Ensure your phone is updated to the latest software. Call Oticon technical support at 855-400-9766 with any questions. End of Year Reminder

If you have coverage for hearing aids, take advantage of the window of benefits before the end of the year when deductibles reset!
